

School Links Activities

Halfway through the school year, we are pleased to have put in place links between six schools in Borehamwood/Elstree and four schools in Fontenay. We have another pen pal exchange in the pipeline for this term.

The teachers sometimes keep in touch via email while the children exchange by post. They send something as a class, gathering cuttings about their schools or specific topics (sports, activities, outings, events, etc.), or write individually, introducing and speaking about themselves.

Artwork such as drawings, collages or cards for exceptional occasions such as The Diamond Jubilee and the Olympic Games last year and regular ones like Christmas, Easter, etc. can also be sent.

Depending on the respective level of the pupils in the two languages, the exchange is either in French or English but can even be in both! It can evolve as the pupils expand their knowledge. Above all, it is about exchanging and getting to know children from a different culture.

This is an exciting venture which has been welcomed with enthusiasm by our local schools, and we look forward to introducing the scheme to other schools.

School trips between our two countries could be planned. Some classes from Fontenay have already shown some interest in visiting Borehamwood/Elstree and, in so doing, possibly getting to meet their pen pal in person. To be continued...

Our aim is to introduce children to the fun of learning French as early as possible, as well as discovering the culture and customs. The general ages of those attending the club are between 6 and 12 years old but this is flexible. The classes are held every Saturday during term time at St Paul's Church Hall, St Paul's Close, (corner of Cranes Way and Furzehill Road) each one is 2 hours long (from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m.). The classes cover the basics of the language (e.g. parts of the body, colours, numbers, positions, greetings, animals, clothes, transports, weather, etc.) through songs, rhymes, activities, cooking sessions, and traditional dances. The classes are run by qualified and fully trained teachers who have a lot of experience teaching children AND are all NATIVE FRENCH SPEAKERS. Children play, learn and are immersed in the French Language throughout the sessions. These activities actively help children with their communications skills and school progress. The adults who run the club are subjected to Enhanced C.R.B. checks, so you can drop the children off with the knowledge that they are in safe hands and go and have some much needed time alone!

FRIDAY 24th May 2013

The trip will leave Borehamwood Ibis Car Park at 6am. Our Journey will take us to Dover where we will Cross by Ferry to Calais, where there will be ample time for you to have a meal.

Our journey will then take us through some of the sights of Northern France to arrive in Fontenay Aux Roses.

On arrival at our accommodation there will be enough time to drop your luggage off, before our coaches' drive to central Fontaney for an evening meal and to enjoy the sights of the town.

Saturday 25th May 2013

Our Coaches will split in two; you will have the option of visiting either:

- A. A Sightseeing Tour of Paris, taking in the Eiffel Tower; Arc de Triomphe, Champs Elysées, Notre Dame Cathedral and Montmartre.
- B. A trip to Versailles; with a guided audio tour of the castle & gardens.

The evening will be free for you to enjoy our French Twin Town.

The Association will organise a restaurant that serves Moroccan Couscous for an additional £30.00 (to be booked and paid for in advance with your application form)

We have also organised a special coach tour of "Paris by Night" – (to be reserved at time of application)

Payment

We require payment **IN FULL** at time of booking to reserve your place on the trip to Fontenay aux Roses from 24th May to 26th May 2013.

Cancellation & refunds

If for any reason, this trip is cancelled by BETTA, then all monies will be returned.

Cancellations will be accepted up until the 15th April 2013, with full refund.

After 15th April 2013, no refunds will be made if you decide to cancel your booking.

Passport

All passports **MUST** have an expiry date of at least six months from the date of travel (i.e. valid until December 2013).

At time of boarding the coach, we will/may check that your passport and visa are current prior to travelling, and reserve the right to refuse travel.

<u>Visas</u>

Any person(s) requiring a visa to enter France **MUST** check with their relevant embassy, and apply in good time for this to be processed.

Behaviour

As this trip represents Elstree & Borehamwood to our twin town, it is expected that all persons will adopt appropriate and civil behaviour during the trip. Thank you.

Travel & Health Insurance

Please arrange your own personal travel insurance for this trip in case of any problems arising. You may find your current bank account already comes with travel insurance, but you should confirm.

Please bring some personal cash with you, which you can buy from any major travel agent that sells euros. Avoid buying currency on the ferry as they charge commission and the rates are not usually very good.

We recommend applying for an EHIC (E111) card that gives free/reduced cost of medical treatment. You can apply online here:

https://www.ehic.org.uk

(It takes less than 10 minutes to apply, you will need your National Insurance number. It takes up to 10 working days to get your card, free of charge)

Baggage

Strictly one item per passenger, weighing up to 12kg/26lbs, with maximum dimensions of 56cm x 41cm x 20cm / 22" x 16" x 8" is permitted. (Handbag, briefcase, laptop, shop purchases, camera, etc. may be carried separately on the coach).

At a BETTA Christmas Social on 19th December 2012 in Fairway Hall three persons from the winning table obtained prizes for a "free" visit to Wembley Stadium.

The party included 2 members of the Committee Rex Dunwoody and Nigel Clark, both keen followers of Arsenal Ladies Football Club whose home pitch is Borehamwood FC

The Tour lasts one and a half hours and is highly recommended - a must for all football followers. The Stadium holds 90,000 spectators and has an unrestricted view from all seats. We visited the Press Office Room where the UK and foreign press question the English and other Managers after the game. The youngsters sat at the Press Conference Table and really enjoyed the experience. We saw the Changing Rooms which included many famous football shirts like Ronaldo and Messi.

Then we went through to where the Players come out of the Tunnel - We were all divided into two teams Torquay and Oxford United who were playing the same evening - It was lovely to see the youngsters savoring the atmosphere and shaking hands with the so called opposition.

We climbed up to the Royal Box, quite a long climb, and had the privilege of holding the FA Cup replica having our photographs taken.

Wembley Stadium is steeped in history and we saw the actual bar of the Goalpost that played a part in the 1966 World Cup where we beat Germany (courtesy of a Russian linesman for those that are old enough to remember!)

Altogether we had a really memorable day and we would recommend the tour to even those that may not follow football. It is definitely an iconic Stadium of which this country can be proud
